



Levi Extreme triathlon 2019: Registration and Competition Rules

Competition rules and rules for admissions to Levi Extreme triathlon 2019. Please read through them with care before registration

Rules for Admission:

Admissions to the 2019 Levi Extreme triathlon will open on Saturday 16.2.2019 at 12:00. Admissions can only be submitted online. Only one person can be submitted at one time. Whether you wish to admit more than 5 persons please contact: triathlon@levi.fi

Cancelling of admission and changing of personal information:

Submitting your admission to the competition is binding and the admission fee is non-refundable.

If a valid doctors note is presented your admission can be moved to the next year. You will get a link in the confirmation email which will allow you will change your personal details. Any changes will need to be made within the application period.

Payment:

Admittance through the online form can only be done via online banking or via credit card, when they payment will the put through the system and will automatically be registered as completed.

If you do not have access to internet banking, or there are some other issues regarding signing-in please contact triathlon@levi.fi

After a successful admittance and payment you will get a confirmation email. Please keep this email safe, you can use it to change your personal information etc.

Other separate payment methods

Currently the only accepted payment methods are online banking or credit card payments. Paying with an exercise or a cultural voucher is not accepted.

License and the right to represent associations or societies:

A Special license is not needed for the competition. Each competitor must have insurance.

Three best in each series will be awarded.

In team competition the three fastest teams will be awarded.

Additionally, there will be an added raffle among all competitors and persons who purchased a raffle ticket, price of the raffle is a Felt B16 triathlon bike.

Within the information for each competition the different series are separated with more details. Age bracket is determined by year of birth, so if a competitor is 49 years old, but turn 50 during the year of competition this person will need to join in the 50-59-year old's' group

Essential rules and guidelines regarding admittance:

- Your admittance is only valid when you have received the confirmation message, the entry fee has been paid, and all information required submitted into the system.

The competitor is responsible for the authenticity of this information at the time of the competition. If any personal information was to change between admittance and actual competition, is the competitor required to correct the information.

Information of the competitors can be used by the event organiser and their partners for information purposes. The organiser will not give out information to third parties.

- Every competitor acknowledges that when they submit their admittance to the competition they understand that the competition situation can cause strain on the body in an abnormal way. In such cases even an hidden and unknown illness can cause a serious risk. Whether you suffer from coronary heart disease, asthma, heart problems, heart palpitations, or other illness that can be aggravated by stress, please talk to your physician regarding risks in taking part in the competition.

- The event organizer will announce official timetables and guidelines online www.levi.fi/extremetriathlon two weeks before the event. Any timetables or guidelines published before this are only referential and they can change. The event organizer does not responsible for any changes to any chargers acquired by the competitors.

- No separate license is needed

- All Finntriathlon-events are part of the antidoping committee. More information:

- Please confirm your admittance in the competition office before the actual competition. At the same time you will receive all competition material. Identity will need to be proved with an official ID. For this reason every competitor is obliged to report to the competition info.
- The competitor is obliged in all series to study the route in advance, that they can run the route as directed. Straying from the marked route will be seen as quitting the race.
- The timekeeping for the competition is done via an electric system. The competitor is responsible for the correct usage and attaching of the timing chip. Score will be determined by the complete time. The complete time is determined from start to cross the finishing line. The event organiser is not responsible for the correctness of interval times or any missing times.
- The routes of the triathlon event have not been precision measured.
- The competition observes in part ETU's and ITU's international competition rules, if the competition guide does not state otherwise. The competitors are not insured by the event organiser, competitors take part at one's own risk. The event organizer has a valid responsibility insurance. On the competition routes normal road traffic rules are valid, unless the competition guidelines state different, or the traffic controller so instructs.
- The bike is to have working brakes and the helmet is to be un-damaged and CE-accepted. The competitor can be required to fix anything lacking before the competition.
- The competition can be seen as discontinued if the finishing line, or arrival to the swimming-bicycle or bicycle-running swap was not crossed in the time limits stated separately. The competition leader, competition judge or medical staff can discontinue or prevent competitors taking part if the competitor in question is seen as being a danger to their own or to fellow competitor's health.
- Whether the competition is cancelled, cut short, or moved completely or in part from some reason outside the control of the event organiser (natural phenomena, force de majeure) the event organiser is not liable for the expenses and the participating fee will not be returned.
- The event organiser and also the producers of sound- and film material have the right to save and use any material made during the event for marketing and publish and share the material publicly.
- When submitting your admission, you give the event organiser permission to publish your name, your series and your society in public participant-, leaving- and results lists.
- Whether a parent is admitting their child into the competition, the parent gives consent to publish their child's name, series and society in public participant-, leaving- and results lists.



- By submitting admittance, you give the event organiser permission to give your name, your series, and your society information to the Finnish Triathlon association, which will check all competitions for representation rights competitor by competitor.
- When submitting your admission, you give the event organizer permission to save the information submitted in the form into Lyyti- upheld system, which will not be given to third parties, apart from any accidents or sickness cases to the first aid personnel.
- When submitting your admission, you give the event organizer permission to add your email address to the organizers post-marketing registry. (=newsletter posting list)
